Summary of Deliverable D2.2 – Public SEAFENNEL4MED Website	The launch of the SEAFENNEL4MED website represented a major step in opening the project to the world. Accessible at www.seafennel4med.com, the site serves as both a communication hub for stakeholders and a showcase for the project's mission: to transform sea fennel into a sustainable, innovative, and Mediterranean flagship crop. The website was designed with two complementary sections. The public section offers accessible, regularly updated information to a broad audience. It presents the project's objectives, descriptions of each partner institution (with links to their websites), news items, press releases, and a calendar of upcoming events. Importantly, it also hosts project outputs in the form of publications, conference presentations, guidelines, and technical notes, making the results available not only to scientists but also to farmers, food companies, policymakers, and citizens. In parallel, the site provides a restricted section for internal communication among consortium partners, enabling the secure exchange of documents, protocols, and draft deliverables. This dual structure ensures both transparency to the outside world and efficiency in collaboration inside the consortium. Beyond being a repository of information, the website functions as a living interface between research and society. By making achievements visible and accessible, it helps foster awareness about sea fennel's potential, encourages stakeholder participation, and supports dissemination and exploitation of results.

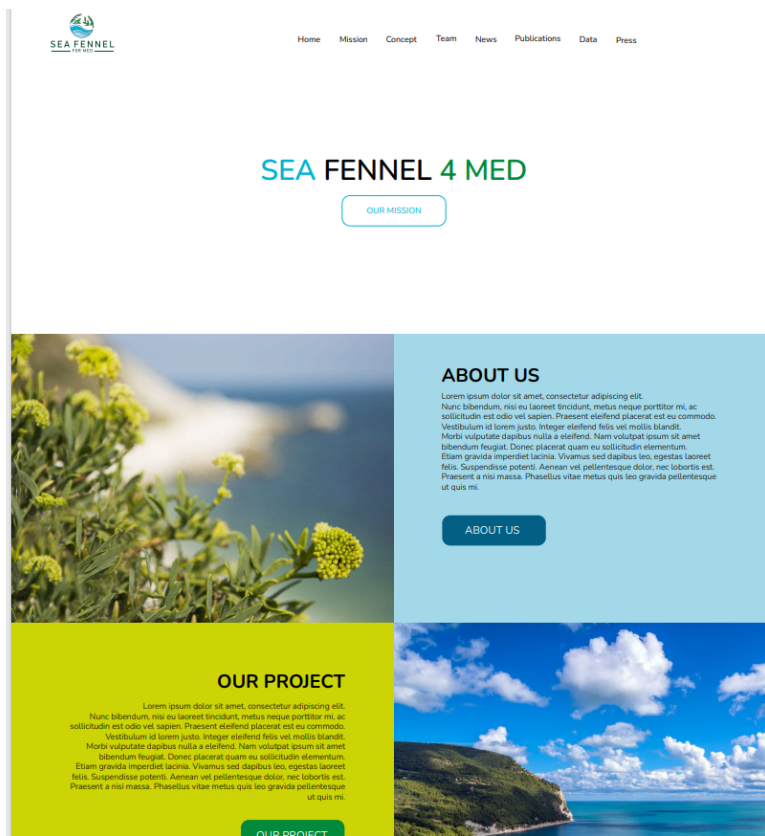
